 - We are required by our licence to inform customers about what happens to funds which we hold on account for you, and the extent to which funds are protected in the event of insolvency.

This means that steps have been taken to protect customer funds but that there is no absolute guarantee that all funds will be repaid. If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit Scotland's Charity Air Ambulance will notify you 5 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Scotland's Charity Air Ambulance to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request

If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Scotland's Charity Air Ambulance or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society – If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Scotland's Charity Air Ambulance asks you to.

You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
